- 5-year old who witnessed her first experience of sight of her mother

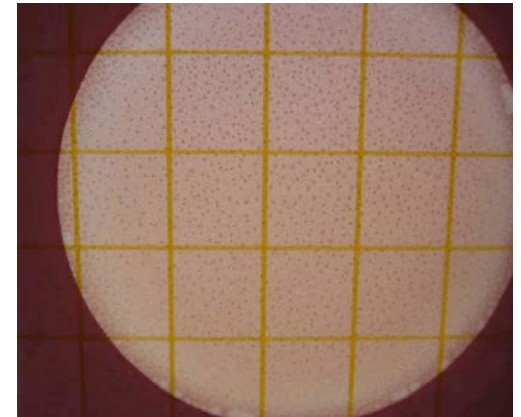

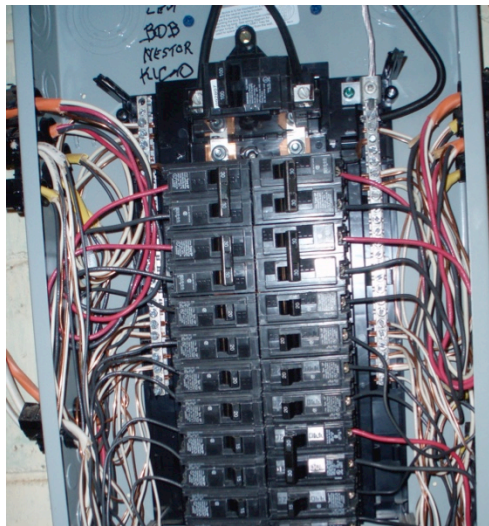
